VERY IMPORTANT: Please don't sign this UNTIL you have read the VNC Codes of Conduct.</i> Along with <b>players, parents and other spectators</b> must abide by our code of conduct.</p>
<p><b>CODE OF CONDUCT - PLAYERS</b></p>
<p>All netballers have a responsibility to practice good sporting behaviour by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Playing by the rules</li> <li>• Never arguing with an official. If you disagree, have your coach and/or team manager approach the official during a break or after the competition</li> <li>• Controlling your temper. Verbal abuse of officials, sledging other players or deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent is not acceptable or permitted in any sport</li> <li>• Working equally hard for yourself and/or your team. Your team's performance will benefit and so will you</li> <li>• Being a good sport by applauding all good plays whether they are made by your team or the opposition</li> <li>• Treating all participants in your sport, as you like to be treated. Do not bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor</li> <li>• Cooperating with your coach, team manager, teammates and opponents. Without them, there would be no competition</li> <li>• Participating for your own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please your parents and coaches</li> <li>• Being considerate to all players (including opposition) coaches and umpires</li> <li>• Actively participating in all training activities and showing a willingness to listen and learn</li> <li>• Having a responsible attitude and ensuring you have the correct equipment with you for training</li> </ul>

i.e. footwear, medication (Asthma) water, snacks, windcheater

**CODE OF CONDUCT – PLAYERS CONTINUED...**

- Ensuring your attitude is positive, encouraging and team focused
- Remembering you are a representative of the Victory Netball Club, Victory Christian College and Victory Church and as such need to display Christ like behaviour
- Wearing the correct netball uniform as outlined in the handbook
- Respecting the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion
- Encouraging of peers, parents, friends, coaches and as such the club expects only positive language and tone at training sessions and games

**Code Violations will result in:**

- Warning
- Warning Two
- Off court game time or request to leave court area
- Recording code violation/s with the club and referral to the committee

**CODE OF CONDUCT – PARENTS AND SPECTATORS**

- **Do not** approach Coaches or Umpires during a game if you have a concern. All concerns need to be forwarded to the Committee in writing either by letter or email, within 24 hours of an incident
- Remember that children participate in sport for their enjoyment, not yours
- Encourage children to participate, do not force them
- Focus on your child's efforts and performance rather than whether they win or lose
- Encourage children to play according to the rules and to settle disagreements without resorting to hostility or violence
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a competition
- Remember that children learn best by example
- Appreciate good performance and skillful plays by all participants
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities
- Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise
- Show appreciation for volunteer coaches, officials and administrators. Without them, your child could not participate
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion

Do not use foul language, make negative comments about any player on either team, sledge or harass players, coaches or officials.

**Actively show appreciation for all volunteer coaches, officials/umpires and administrators.**

Without them, your child could not participate.

Players are to return their hired uniform promptly at the end of their season or at the latest by the annual Presentation Day/Night.
